She was escorted by Ms Deepa Nair, Rtn Gautam Jha of Rotary Club of Delhi East End and Ms Simmi Behl from Rotary (Delhi NCR) Gift of Life Trust.

Simon had recurrent hospital admissions for pneumonia ever since he was born. He was found suffering from congenital heart disease. Simon required urgent corrective open heart surgery. The case was referred to Gift of Life New Delhi by 'Africa Vision of Hope' through Gift of Life International on 23 December 2013 after getting the reference from 'Samaritan's Purse'. Gift of Life New Delhi cleared the case for surgery on 24 December 2013. Simon, Japhet Sausande and Suzen Chunga reached New Delhi on 2 February 2014. Simon underwent successful open heart surgery on 04 Feb 2014. Rotarians visited the hospital, met the child and offered motherly care. Simon after complete recuperation left Delhi for Zambia on 25 February 2014.

Japhet is a school Principal, also a pastor. He lives outside of Lusaka, Zambia. Simon is the third and youngest child. Simon's mother Suzen Chunga speaks very little English. Her native tongue is Nyanja. 'African Vision of Hope' is an NGO set up in US and Zambia at Kafue. Mr Andrew Phiri, is the Director of operations for African Vision of Hope. Simon's surgery was coordinated by Mr Judi Bertels, President/CEO, African Vision of Hope, Maryville, IL Rtn Rob Raylman, Executive Director, Gift of Life International, New York.

Fathima Hafsa, 3.3 years, female, Sri Lanka came to Delhi for open heart surgery on 18 February 2014. She was referred by Rotary Club of Colombo.



Fathima's father M.M. Iyoob is Fisherman by occupation and mother S. Fathima Nalifa is housewife

They hail from a remote area - Kalmunai in the East of Sri Lanka. The father's average income is 50 – 60\$ per month. They can only communicate in Tamil (and cannot speak English or Sinhala). Fathima has an elder brother aged 6 years.

Mr Gamini Nanayakkara coordinated the project from Sri Lanka side and Rtn Dinal Pieres from Lanka Aluminium Industries Plc arranged flight tickets and pocket money from his personal savings.

The child was successfully operated at Fortis Escorts Heart Institute, New Delhi on 24 Feb 2014. After recuperation, child left for Sri Lanka on 18 March 2014.



Lydia Sabu, 10 years, female, Koothattukulam, Kerala was admitted at Escorts hospital on 25 Feb 2014.



Lydia was operated on 27 Feb 2014 and discharged after total recuperation on 05 March 2014.



Anjali Rawat, 2.6 years, female from Uttarkhand was admitted at Escorts hospital on 01 March 2014. She underwent successful open heart surgery on 10 March 2014. After recuperation, she was discharged on 24 March 2014.

Tariq Hussain, 1.6 years, Male, J & K was admitted at Escorts Hospital on 10 Feb 2014. Tariq was found OK for surgery after tests and evaluation. However, child's father took the child, despite persuasion and counselling, before surgery.



Tenzin Yangzom, female, 4 years, daughter of Tashi Phuntsok working for the Central Tibetan Administration, Office of H.H. The Dalai Lama, Dharamsala was suffering from congenital heart disease every since her birth on 3 February 2010. It was after six months of birth that the parents noticed her difficulties while breathing. Dr. Tseten la of Tibetan Delek Hospita diagnosed it as ASD with 13 mm. Since both parents are working for Central Tibetan Administration, also known as [Tibetan Government in exile](#) and their salary is very minimal, they could not afford the cost of surgery.



The parents approached Gift of Life New Delhi for assistance to save the life of Tenzin. After going through Tibetan divination, the parents found that the month of January was best for her surgery. As per their wish, admission was arranged on 14 January 2014. She was successfully operated on 16 Jan 2014. Tenzin Yangzom was discharged from hospital on 21 January 2013. After follow up, the child and parents returned to their native place on February 2014.



Navas Safiya Nazar, 5 years, male, Palakad, Kerala came to Delhi on 03 Mar 2014 for open heart surgery. He was admitted at Escorts hospital on 08 Mar 2014.



He underwent surgery on 10 March 2014. After recuperation, he was discharged on 18 March 2014



Aleiya Hameed, 7 years, female, Muvattupuzha underwent detailed evaluation and tests at Escorts hospital, New Delhi on 10 March 2014. She was treated for her CHD. Upon detailed evaluation, she was found not requiring open heart surgery.

Singh has been instrumental in getting the DDF released for Gift of Life M.G. from his Dist. PDG Rtn PP Singh supported financially many families who are financially weak by meeting expenses of travel and stay at Delhi. His devotion to Gift of Life saw many underprivileged children suffering from CHD receiving Gift of Life surgery and thus new lease of life for them.

Rtn P.P.Singh had served the Club as President in the year 1994-95 and 2001-02. He was awarded Global Quest World Winner Award by RI President Richard D. King at Barcelona Convention in Spain. He was instrumental for 800% membership increase in his club. This is recorded in Limca Book of Records in its 2004 edition. Rtn. P.P. He had received Awards from Rotary International for Highest Net Membership Growth, Highest Number of New Clubs and Highest contribution in Zone 6-A.

PDG P.P. Singh had attended four RI Conventions - Barcelona Spain, Chicago U.S.A., Birmingham U.K., Bangkok Thailand and also attended RI Polio Summit and RI Goodwill Summit.

PDG P.P. Singh is Chairman of a school for mentally challenged children (differently abled children) namely Pooja Seva Sansthan at Bareilly. It is supported by Rotary Club of Bareilly North and Innerwheel Club of Bareilly New North.
